Rhiannon paints large murals with primary and secondary school children. She will sketch the design in the first hour and then work with groups of children throughout the day to create their very own masterpiece! Once the painting has been done, Rhiannon uses her final hour to outline everything in black. Children are all told that there are no rules regarding colour or pattern. They are encouraged to use their imagination and be brave with colour. The sky doesn't have to be blue and the grass doesn't have to be green. Rhiannon suggests painting 'rainbow pathways' and 'spotty trees'. Murals normally feature the school and local area so children can get familiar with buildings and sceneries around them. Pupils on the mural are coloured in with different skin and hair colours and words such as 'respect' 'safe' 'kindness' are often included. Welsh words are also scattered over the painting such as 'Cymraeg' 'Teulu' and 'Dysgu'. All in all, Rhiannon aims to create a mural that's fun, colourful, educational and inclusive. Disney music is played all day and the children always have a really fun and relaxing experience!
